### 1.4 Objectives (max. 2,000 characters, with spaces)

What change is expected?

### 1.5 Relation to microfinance (max 1,500 characters, with spaces)

The proposal must use microfinance as a tool to solve or at least mitigate the problem. Indicate which aspects of microfinance are highlighted and why. Also, please indicate the role of the National Body for Microcredit in a project stemming from the proposal.

1.6 Relation to a European policy (max. 2,000 characters, with spaces)
