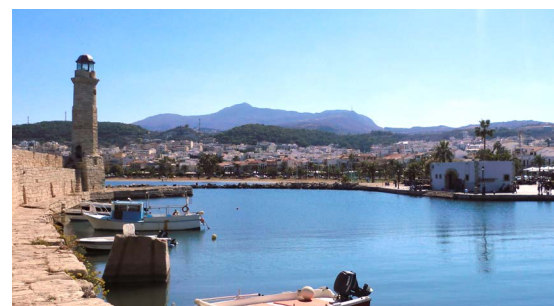
The Summer School follows a traditional structure: lectures in the
